99 Otis Street LLC - Fully Leased

- 31,410 SF corporate headquarters building at Griffiss Park
- Joint venture between NYSTEC and GLDC (99 Otis St. LLC)
- Second floor: NYSTEC awarded contract for fit out of interior space (+10 new jobs)
- First floor: Booz Allen Hamilton (+ 60 new jobs) and investing \$1.6M (March 2020)
- NYSTEC completion date: September 2019
- Ribbon Cutting held October 16



Building 240 Redevelopment Site - Bonacio Construction



- \$20.8 million Mixed Use Development project at Griffiss Business & Technology Park
- Phase 1: 84 units of market rate apartments & 36,550 SF of commercial space
- Construction began October 2019, with completion expected by Fall 2020

Orgill Distribution Center

- Phase 1: 777,600 SF with
- Expansion of 250,000 SF
- Orgill purchasing 64 + acres from GLDC
- 225 full time jobs over 5 years
- \$71 million investment

- Open Innovation Campus: a collaborative hub that will produce revolutionary research from those on the forefront of cutting-edge technology

 Oneida County, Griffiss Institute, SUNY Poly
 - Campus will look to use Quantum Information Processing to analyze and improve such things as computer hardware and software, data protection, cybersecurity and artificial intelligence







- New sculpture Vietnam Veterans Memorial by The New York State Vietnam Veterans Memorial Inc
- ► Trail improvements Shade trees planted along trail as part of 5-year plan, completed connections to the Mohawk River Trail (working with the City on Phase 2 from Chestnut to Delta Dam)
- ► Long-range planning Draft completed of the Open Space Management Plan, designed new wayfinding signage and drafted a wayfinding location plan for 2020 installation
- ► Family activities GPLA hosted a movie night on the Park, with over 100 people in attendance



2019 GLDC's Year in Review

- ▶ \$700,598,868 Million in CapEx since Griffiss Park was created in 1995
- ▶ \$3.7 Million in taxes generated from Griffiss Park, 7.3% of the City of Rome's total Property Tax Revenue
- ► Over 5,886 employees work at Griffiss from over 25 Counties
- ► More than **72 Businesses operate** inside Griffiss
- ► STEM wages average \$99,000 annually
- ► 2018 AFRL Economic Impact: \$412,268,595
- ▶ 2020 Projects: Orgill distribution center, Air City Lofts, Dr. Vinci Medical Building, Booz Allen Hamilton fit out at 99 Otis St, transfer Building 302 from the Air Force, leverage UAV/UAS activities into a major project, and connect Griffiss Park with the Woodhaven Redevelopment Activity
